MEMBERSHIP CLASSIFICATIONS

- PRODUCER** - Minimum annual dues are \$225.
- CONTRACTOR** - Minimum annual dues are \$225.
- ALLIED INDUSTRY** - For each Ohio outlet minimum annual dues are \$250. Allied Industry includes service and supply companies, manufacturers, refineries, utilities, etc.
- PROFESSIONAL** - Minimum annual dues are \$225. Includes accountants, attorneys, bankers, consultants, geologists, geophysicists, insurance representatives, petroleum engineers, etc.
- ASSOCIATE** - Minimum annual dues are \$225. Includes members of companies that already have a member listed under one of the above categories.
- ROYALTY OWNERS** - Minimum annual dues are \$25. Limited to landowners receiving royalties from oil and/ or natural gas wells.
- STUDENT** - Minimum annual dues are \$30. Limited to full time students. A Student membership may not exceed seven annual renewals or eight years.

CORPORATE - OOGA has three special "Explorer Foundation" Corporate memberships available. Corporate members receive special recognition at all OOGA meetings, in the Bulletin and on the Association's website:

- Discovery:** Minimum dues are \$7,500. Includes up to 25 members listed in any combination of the above outlined classifications.
- Wildcat:** Minimum dues are \$3,750. Includes up to 12 members listed in any combination of the above outlined classifications.
- Scout:** Minimum dues are \$1,875. Includes up to 6 members listed in any combination of the above outlined classifications.

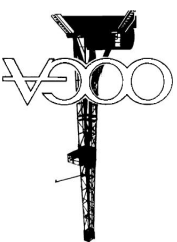
