Engine/Compressor Maintenance Analyst

Job Summary:

This position involves the gathering of vibration, pressure, and ignition data from operating gas compressor units. The data is then analyzed for abnormal trends that may indicate mechanical deterioration or failure of the unit. Emission testing is also performed under the guidelines of the air quality operating permit as issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection.

Other responsibilities include tracking and reporting of test results. Working with other groups to coordinate and facilitate mechanical repairs that may be necessary to correct any abnormal conditions discovered through the analysis process. Provide information and assist with failure analysis investigations. Provide support and technical assistance for system software, hardware, and peripherals. Monitor and evaluate software and hardware technologies. Maintain control systems to ensure the efficient operation of engine / compressor unit. Assist with training of compressor station personnel in basic maintenance procedures.

Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:

- Mechanical background is a must.
- Knowledge of the physical properties of natural gas as it goes through the combustion and compression process.
- Knowledge of compressor station operations and reciprocating engines is preferred.
- Logical and analytical thinking abilities.
