The focus of this role is the continued development and implementation of the IMP.

- Leads process improvements and oversees, reviews and audits internal program deliverables.
- Creates project plans, process maps, schedules, cost estimates, contract specifications and IT/business requirements.
- Supports process tools.
- Manages and communicates changes.
- Interfaces with all parts of the organization involved with Pipeline Safety and in the IMP, including vendors and contractors.
- May act in a training mode for inexperienced personnel.
- Facilitates team consensus decisions.
- Manages multiple tasks.
- Ensures compliance with codes and Company policies and standards.
- This role will be required to present and support data during audits.
